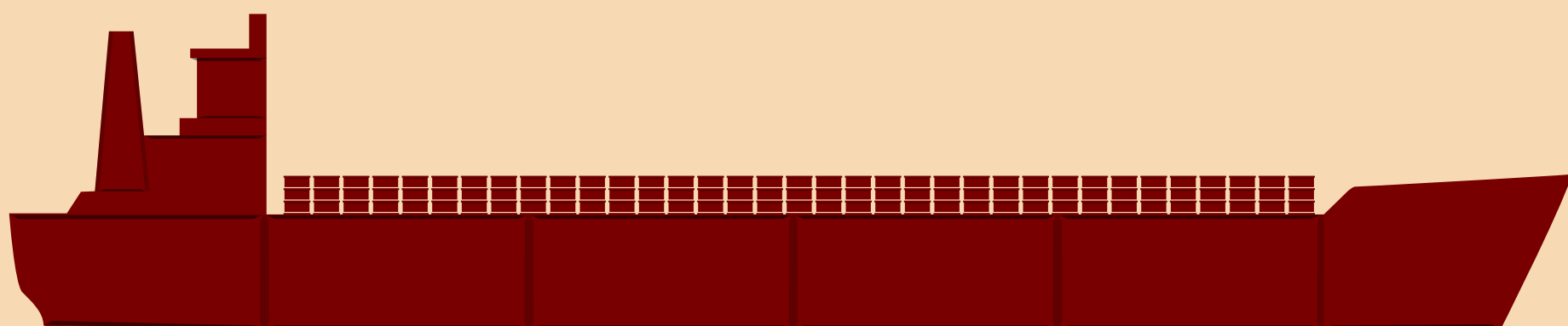


Non-Container Shipping Methods



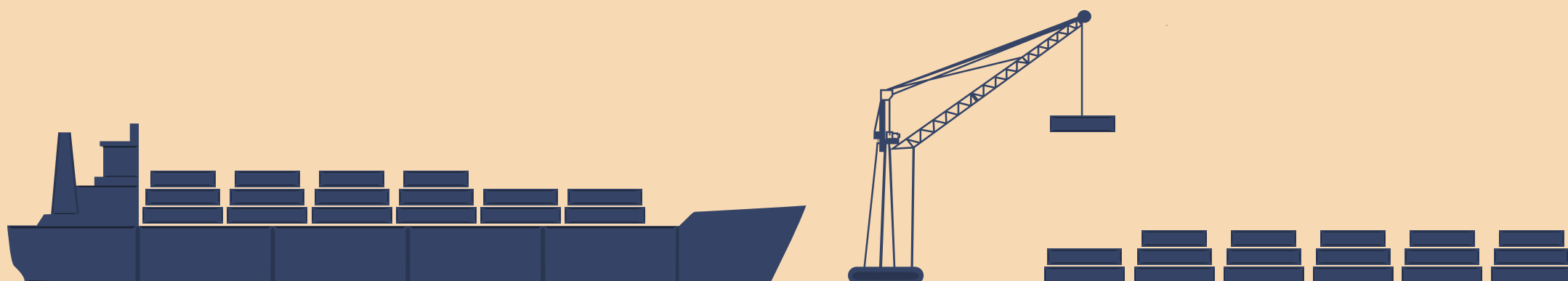
On Deck Non-Containerized

This shipping method refers to shipments that are stored directly on the deck without the protection of a container.



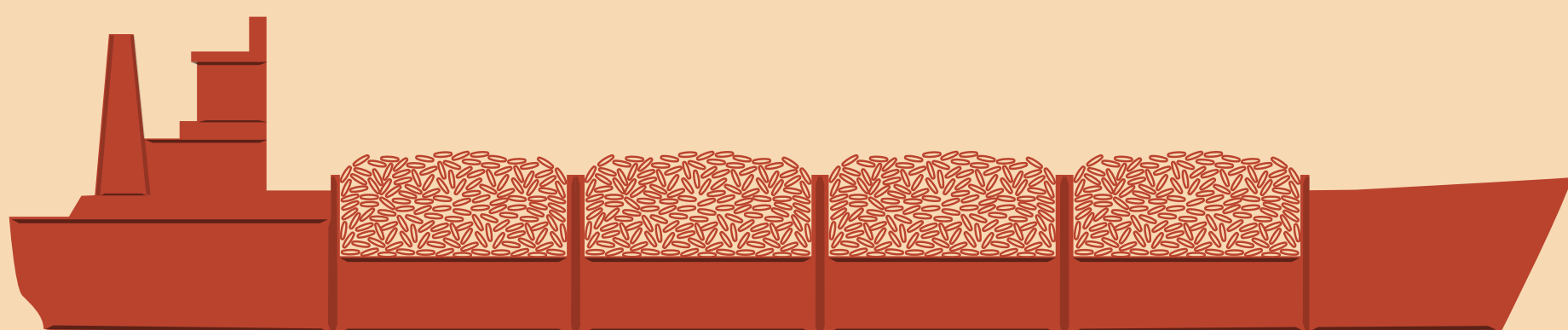
Roll On / Roll Off (RORO)

ROROs are vessels designed to carry wheeled cargo that are driven on and off the ship on their own wheels or using a platform vehicle.



Break Bulk

Break bulk cargo (or general cargo) are goods that must be loaded individually and not in shipping containers nor in bulk, as with oil or grain.



Bulk Shipping

Bulk shipping is primarily for commodities such as Grain and Crude Oil which are loaded into specially designed ships filled with only that commodity.
